- Demonstrate existence of procedures to prevent money laundering, fraud, bribery & conflicts of interests.

LABOR AND HUMAN RIGHTS

- Comply with all applicable laws in accordance with the principles of the International Labor Organization, OECD Guidelines on Forced Labor & Conflict Minerals, UN Global Compact and UN Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
- Prohibit slavery and the use of forced, bonded, or child labor across the supply chain, in adherence with our <u>Statement on Slavery and Human Trafficking.</u>
- Prohibit unlawful discrimination and harassment to provide a safe and inclusive work environment.
